You should enter a WorldSkills Australia competition if:

- You are excelling at your skill or trade
- You want to challenge yourself and learn new skills
- You want a competitive edge in the job market

You can enter a WorldSkills
Australia competition if you are:

- Undertaking an apprenticeship or traineeship
- Undertaking studies towards a qualification at an RTO/ TAFE or University

To enter a regional WorldSkills Australia competition:

- Register online or with your regional coordinator
- Receive email confirmation
- Confirm registration details at the event on day of competition



Even if you don't think you're good enough or skilled enough, try anyways! At worst it'll be a good learning experience, at best you'll be involved in something bigger then you can anticipate.
